

REFLECTING ON LETTER OF ST. MICHAEL GARICOITS

TO A LADY; NAME NOT KNOWN (1827)

I am guite late replying to your letter and I fear this may have upset you. However you can always be sure that I never forgot you before the Lord. It always consoles me to think of the graces he has given you and to which, I do not hesitate to say, you have responded so generously. Oh! how you should rejoice in the Lord for having said yes; when you were your own mistress and free to do what you wanted, and he asked you to renounce that freedom and to offer it up again. To reward you for this generous sacrifice, he gave you his divine heart and assured you of the eternal possession of it by the consecration that you have made him of yourself. With what joy you must have renewed this same consecration the day before yesterday. How many graces will the divine Heart give you because of the promise you have made. Correspondence F.V.D. first period: 1825 -1833 Following on from this, try in spite of your feelings of unworthiness to approach...Do not dream of changing your confessor. He is a good priest who has always given you good advice. Put aside your feelings and the effect they have on you. Remember 'To you, alone, O Jesus, you alone.' (I am assuming that there is nothing unseemly or inappropriate in your dealings with your confessor). That being the case, what would be the point of changing? Soon you would experience the same discontent with another, and then with a third... etc. Do not alter anything in your way of life. Trust and be brave! In the crown of the spouse is the crown of the martyrs. Farewell, Sister, all generations will call you blessed .My Jesus, my good master, I am no longer for myself but all yours. Do with me what you will. Here I am ... O my master, I am happy to serve you.

MINISTRY WITH MIGRANTS

The archdiocese of Bangalore formed the commission for the migrants in the year October 2015. Soon after its formation, the commission has been organizing various programs for the migrant's community in the archdiocese of Bangalore.

The CRI has taken up the responsibility to care the migrants under the direction of Archbishop and his council members and I have been appointed as the full time working secretary (Executive secretary). There are 25 fathers, 30 sisters and more than 50 lay animators associate with this ministry actively



in this ministry in the archdiocese other than independent migrant pastoral care units. The commission members extend wholehearted support towards every concern of the migrants in the archdiocese and encouraged everyone to come out of their fear and live happily.

The commission organises various programmes for the migrants for the pastoral care throughout year such as, creation of pastoralcare centres (mass centres) wherever is necessary (at present we are having more than 25 centres for pastoral care), occasional gathering for different ethnic groups in view of orientation and mobilization for the distressed migrants, cultural sharing, international migrants day on every 2nd Sunday of January, migrant unorganised workers day on 2nd of October_etc... the migrant community has consists of people from African continent,

Sri Lanka, Nepal, Bhutan, North East of India and other speaking Hindi states. The commission has identified more than 10,000 migrants in different centres who are directly or indirectly associated



with us for various needs. In addition to pastoral care, the commission extends support for legal, employment, refugee care works, health care and insurance, social security through formation of organization and association. I have been part of human rights commission with regard to social justice and anti-human trafficking move-

The hostel children were too happy to see the loving grandparents. "The Park Friends" said they contribute



once in a month Rs. 200 each and visit the near by care homes to give whatever things possible. It is the material things are important rather the heart that wants to give and share. It was a good example for the proverb "feathers of the same flock fly together " it is because all were from different communities, religion. I could find few elderly Hindu men, few Muslim men and few Christian. It shows their unity in diversity. I said to one of the members quoting Mother Theresa "when we pray we come closer to God, When we serve God comes closer to us" it was true. They all were happy. All found their real happiness in serving, caring and loving the young children who really need the tender loving care of the elders.

My mission in India

I would like to share in brief about my experience while doing my ministry in Chennai at Royapuram in St. Peter's Church. At first I felt little lonely because I don't know anybody there except Fr. John Britto. I was completely new to the place. As the days went by I began feel at ease and started to talk to the people and also the children. I was really happy to share the life style of my country to children. The people and the children were interested to listen and also treated me as friend.



On Sunday's I helped for catechism classes for the children. I could see the people there loved to come for the Sunday masses. It was a beautiful opportunity for me to express my faith by teaching them about Jesus and some basic prayers. The people were happy to send their children for the catechism classes. In the beginning there were only a few children coming for the catechism classes but slowly the number increased. As I taught them, I also learned many things from them.

During the month of November, the restoration of the church began. So, I spend most of time helping to clean the church from inside. The parishioners were really happy to see their church so beautiful and they loved there their church.
